Whether you have signed up for one or more days of for RGC construction work or just may be interested in what we are doing, here are details of this construction project.

### **Start date**

Start date is this Saturday, 9/19. Prayer and kick-off meeting is at 7am. The slab will have been poured by that time and framing will begin. Permanent power on site is still several days off so we'll be using generators on Saturday.

### **Meals**

On this particular Saturday and on all weekdays, RGC will provide coffee in the morning as well as lunch somewhere around noon. Food and serving arrangements will focus on a singular purpose...to keep the project rolling.



### **Contact**

For Monday 9/21 and beyond, Bob and Betty Thibault or Bob and Pat Cairns at RGC will contact and remind those who have signed up for work on particular dates.

### **Safety**

- Safety glasses are a *must* in the vicinity of power saws and nailing operations.
- There is no place for kids to run loose on the property; kids must be kept within arms reach of parents. There is a place for teens to help if they are motivated. Teens should not wear shorts.

## Tools

Required:

- *Safety glasses*

The following items will be immediately useful:

- Hammer
- Tape measure
- Utility knife
- Speed square
- Pencil
- Tool belt

The following items may be useful if you already have them:

- Hammer stapler (to fit T50 staples)
- Knee protectors
- Circular saw
- Cordless drill
- Other tools that you may consider helpful for framing (not air tools)

Also, there will be some landscaping work, so bring pruning equipment, shears, weed whackers, etc, if you are so inclined.



## Bathrooms

Bathrooms are porti-pottys. These are in really good shape and relatively clean. (Can porti-pottys ever be clean???)

## Parking

Park on the mowed field area before the porti-pottys and storage container. Leave clear the traveled driveway that parallels Ballard Road.

## Finding us

RGC is ½ mile south of the Georgia Rt. 89 interchange 18 on Route 7. Turn right (west) onto Ballard Road. The entrance is 3/10 mile down Ballard Road on the right between the posts wrapped in yellow tape.



## Management and hierarchy

Essentially RGC owns the framing, sheathing, Tyvek, siding, trusses, roofing, windows, doors, and painting. Almost everything else will be subcontracted. James Powell is

managing the overall project as well as personally managing the subcontractors he has hired. Don Crawford and a few others will be assisting James as necessary.
